

EMILY BUTLER
MARCH 7, 1898 – FEBRUARY 1, 1928

Emily Butler (nee Johnson) was born March 7, 1898. Her Father's surname was Johnson and her Mother's maiden name was Griffin. She married Leonard Butler about 1915-16 However, a marriage record was not found.

The 1910 Census Records, records Leonard, 13, living in Justice Precinct 3, Tarrant County, Texas as a stepson to Dick Westoll and Low Westoll. His sisters Classie, 16, and Ola, 14 were also living in this household.

Leonard Butler registered for WWI in June 1917. He states that he was born in December 1893 and that he is married with 2 children. He states that he is working for Armour & Company as a laborer.

The 1920 Census Records, records Emily Butler, 21, living in Arlington, Tarrant County, Texas with her husband Leonard Butler, 24, and their children, Elizabeth, 6 and Lemuel, 4.

Emily Butler died February 1, 1928, according Her Death Certificate. Liza Johnson, her daughter, was the informant on the Death Certificate and states that Emily Butler was born January 4, 1902, and was 26 years of age which disagrees with her headstone. She was a housewife at the time of her death. Death Certificate states that her father was surnamed Johnson and was born in Texas and her Mother was surnamed Griffin and was born in Mississippi. A posting on Find a Grave. Shows birth date as March 7, 1898 but shows the correct date of death.

Leonard Butler also has a posting on Find a Grave that shows he died October 16, 1928 and is buried at the Wynne Unit Prison Cemetery, Huntsville, Walker County, Texas. Leonard was sentenced to 2 years for swindling but died before his sentence was complete.
